

## Download and Installation Instructions for OverDrive Media Console ( 8 steps )

1. Click the 'Click to download OverDrive Media Console Version 2.1' link to start the download process. - *A 'File Download' box is displayed.*
2. Select option 'Save' or 'Save this program to disk'. Browse to (and make note of) a location to save the file, and click the 'OK' button to download the OverDrive Media Console install file (ODMediaConsoleSetup.exe) to your machine. - *The file will be saved to the location you noted.*
3. If you are using IE 5.0 or higher, a dialog box may be displayed when the download is complete. Click the 'Open' button to begin the installation. Otherwise, locate the '.exe' file (ODMediaConsoleSetup.exe), and double-click it to begin installation. - *The 'OverDrive Media Console Setup Wizard' is displayed.*
4. Click the 'Next >' button to begin the installation process. - *The 'Software License Agreement' screen is displayed.*
5. Review the 'Software License Agreement', and select the 'I Agree' option (if you agree). Then, click the 'Next >' button. - *The 'Select Installation Folder' screen is displayed.*
6. At the 'Select Installation Folder' screen, either browse to the location to which you would like to save the program, or leave the default location. Also, indicate whether you want the program to be accessible to 'Everyone' or 'Just me', (Windows Vista users – use “Just Me”) then click the 'Next >' button. - *The 'Confirm Installation' screen is displayed.*
7. Click the 'Next >' button to start installation. - *When the installation is complete, the 'Installation Complete' window will be displayed.*
8. Click the 'Close' button to exit the wizard. - *Once the installation is complete, you may delete the install file (ODMediaConsoleSetup.exe).*

## How to download an OverDrive audio book title ( 4 steps )

1. After checking out an OverDrive audio book title, click on the 'Download' link for the title. - *The OverDrive Media Console opens, and the 'Get Media' dialog box is displayed.*  
The 'Get Media' dialog box prompts you to specify the location to which the file(s) you download will be saved :
2. Click 'OK' to save the files to the default location, or click the 'Browse...' button to specify a different location on your computer, then click 'OK'.
3. The 'Download Part(s)' dialog box is displayed. At the 'Download Part(s)' dialog box, you can specify the part(s) of the titles you want to download. By default, all available parts are selected for download :
4. Use the checkboxes to indicate the part(s) you want to download, and click 'OK'.  
The 'Download Part(s)' dialog box closes, and your download begins. The progress of the download of each part is displayed in OverDrive Media Console. The download may take several minutes, depending in part on the number of parts selected for download the size of these parts:

## How to navigate and play an OverDrive audio book (1 step)

1. Once your download is complete, the title is displayed in OverDrive Media Console :  
With the title you want to play selected, click the 'Play' button. The OverDrive Media Explorer™ window is displayed, and begins to play the title you selected.

For ease of download and use, OverDrive audio books are divided into *Parts*, and *Parts* are then divided into logical sections (such as chapters for audio books). The beginning points of these logical sections are called 'MediaMarkers™'. Use *Parts* and *MediaMarkers* to skip directly to, and begin play at, a desired point in a title. Click on the desired *Part* to display associated *MediaMarkers*. Click the desired *MediaMarker* to start play at that point in the file.

## How to transfer an OverDrive audio book to an MP3 player (6 steps)

1. Connect your MP3 player to your computer. Wait for it to be identified and installed and ready for use.
2. In OverDrive Media Console, highlight the title you wish to transfer and click the 'Transfer' button. - *The OverDrive Media Console Transfer Wizard is displayed.*
3. Verify that the correct title is displayed on the first screen of the Transfer Wizard and click 'Next'.  
The Transfer Wizard will search for a connected portable device.
  - If your device is detected the 'Confirm' screen is displayed.
  - If your device is not detected, the Transfer Wizard will display a message stating that 'no portable players could be found.'
4. In the 'Confirm' dialog box, select the part(s) you want to transfer by checking the box(es) next to the part name(s).
5. Click 'Next' to begin transferring the file(s) to your device.  
When the file transfer is complete, the Transfer Wizard displays a 'success' message.
6. Click 'Finish' to exit the Transfer Wizard.
  - Do NOT disconnect your player until you click the Safely Remove Hard icon on the toolbar.
